**Within-Herd Heritability Estimated with Daughter-Parent Regression for Yield and Somatic Cell Score.** *By Dechow and Norman, page 482.* Heritability is often assumed to be constant across herds, but management differences may impact the value of a herd's records for genetic evaluations. Within-herd heritabilities that were generated rapidly with regression varied from 0 to 0.93 across herds and could be incorporated into genetic selection programs to improve accuracy.
